Statement from OMB Director Shaun Donovan:

**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled
“Establishing an Emergency Board to Investigate a Dispute Between
New Jersey Transit Rail and Certain of its Employees
Represented by Certain Labor Organizations”**

This executive order establishes a Presidential Emergency Board to investigate and report on a labor dispute between New Jersey Transit Rail and some of its employees. Implementing this executive order is anticipated to have a de minimis impact on costs and no impact on revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of the executive order include assisting parties to resolution in a labor dispute. Implementing this executive order is anticipated to have a de minimis impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, and no impact on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2015. The agency anticipated to be impacted by this executive order is the National Mediation Board.
