
Toxicity values for dioxin: U.S. EPA vs other regulatory agencies

Bottom line: The toxicological values for dioxin recently proposed by the U.S. EPA are lower than the values developed by other regulatory and public health agencies around the world.



Notes: Comparison of EPA health-based values (cancer and non-cancer) for dioxin relative to health-based values that have been used historically by other international agencies (values may not represent the most current values). Values presented represent daily intake limits (e.g., risk-specific doses, tolerable daily intakes).
