Definition of resinated wood and resinated trim:

Resinated wood means wood products (containing resin_binders and adhesives) derived from produced by primary and secondary wood products manufacturing.

Resinated wood includes residues from the manufacture and use of resinated wood, including materials and comprised of such items as board trim, sander dust, and panel trim, and off-specification resinated wood products.

Suggested changes to March 2011 NHSM definitions.

- Clarifies the spectrum of resinated materials currently used as fuels throughout the wood product manufacturing process
- Includes definition of resinated wood trim to include broad class of materials produced at wood product mills.
