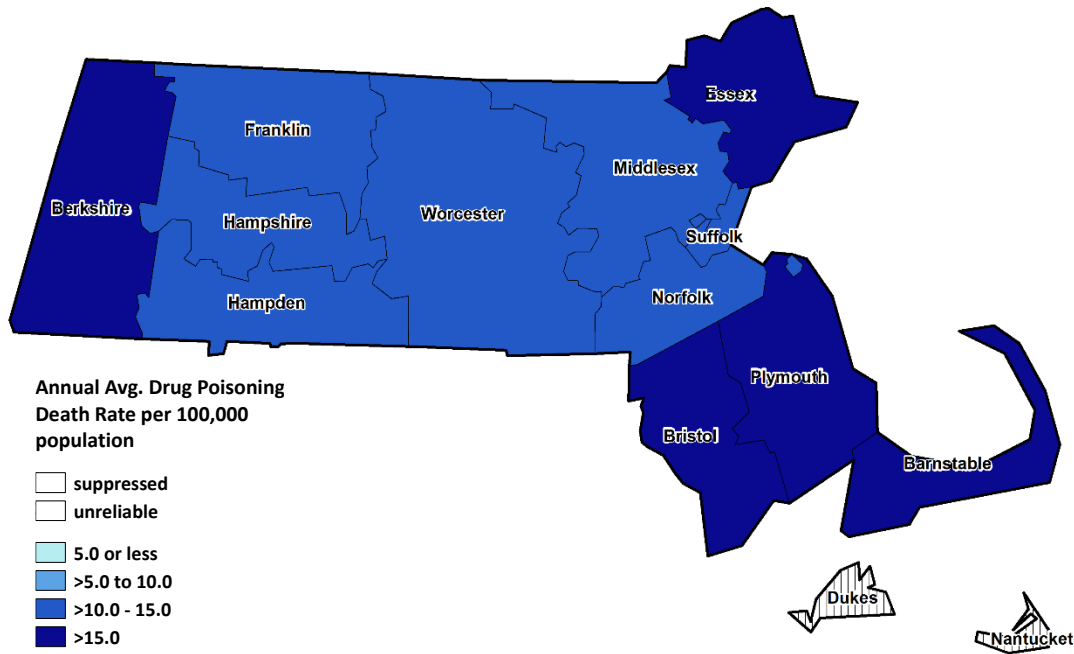

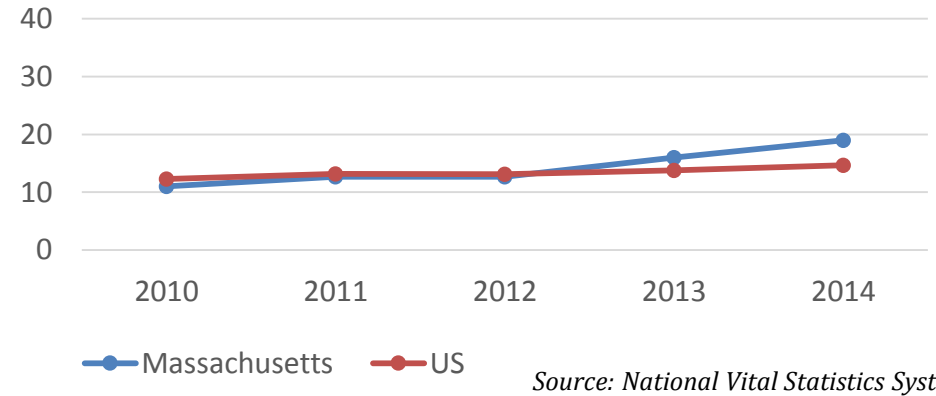
Drug Poisoning Death Rate per 100,000, by County, 2010-2014



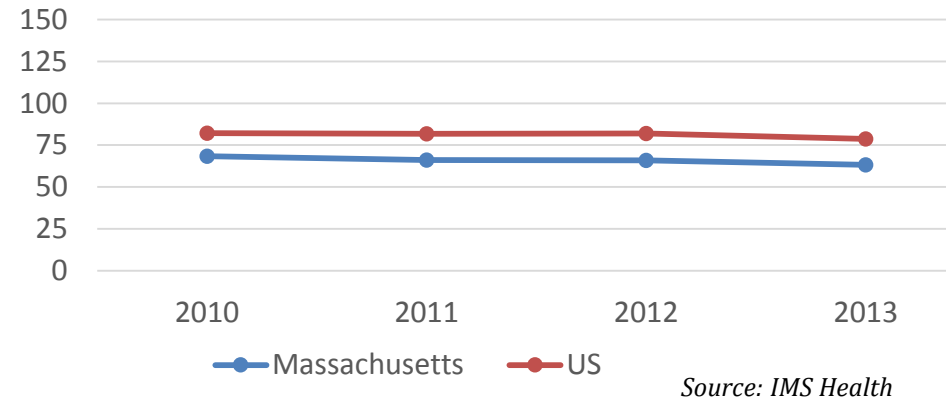

Under the President's budget proposal, Massachusetts would be eligible for up to **\$20 million dollars** over 2 years to expand access to treatment for opioid use disorders.
