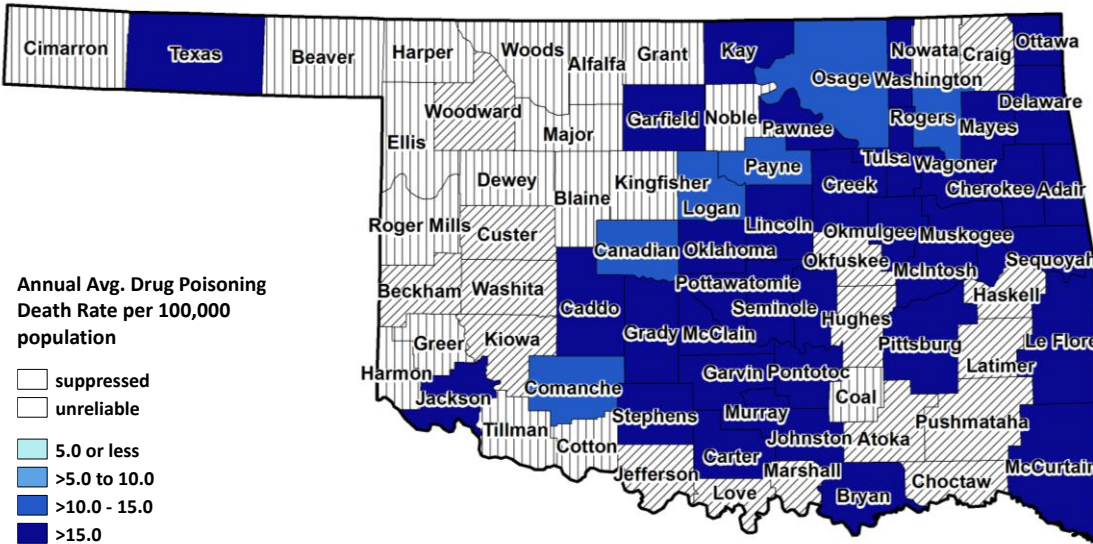

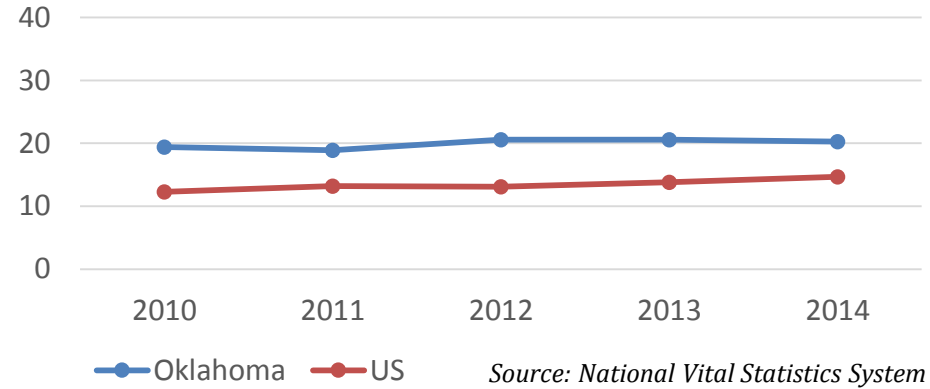
**Drug Poisoning Death Rate per 100,000, by County, 2010-2014**



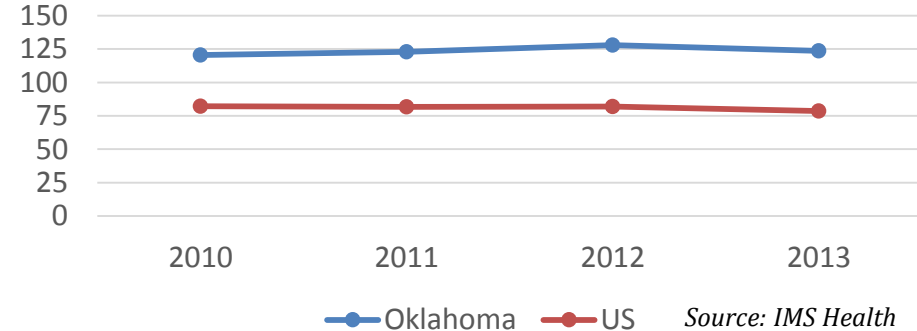
